

Our Waiau Pa show home is open by appointment. We'd love to show you around. Our beautifully finished 275 sqm brick and cedar country show home takes full advantage of its peaceful setting in Waiau Pa. It incorporates four generous bedrooms, two bathrooms and generous master suite.

The open plan layout connects the living and dining area with a large kitchen that features a hidden scullery. Triple car garaging and storage throughout the home is a practical addition to make it a comfortable home for family living.

Modelled on the original 80 sqm cottage that was on the site previously, the newly built home is just on 300 square metres. It has four bedrooms and two bathrooms, a separate toilet, large open plan living and separate media room.

High stud throughout the home creates a warm and inviting sense of space. Two large verandahs either side

of the home capture the morning and afternoon sun. A large family laundry room offers plenty of practical storage space.

Wood paneling detail throughout the home is a further nod to tradition along with a calming neutral colour palette; complemented by a few bold splashes of colour, we love the statement wallpaper!

This seemingly traditional country home is at the forefront of modern tech, with extensive Control4 smart technology managing everything from security systems, audio, lighting, heating and blinds, to controlling efficient use of the energy generated by a solar system with energy storage and generator back up. Materials and systems were selected with their sustainability attributes paramount.

The design principles throughout remain true to Harrison Lane's core values; strong, substantial oversized aesthetics and dramatic proportions; created throughout with the use of high stud and vaulted ceilings.



A highlight is the sense of scale created throughout the home with the dramatic roof gable pitch and raked ceilings.





HARRISON LANE SHOW BARN


We'd be delighted to show you around our Highgrove barn-style show home located at our office in Waiau Pa.

It is perfectly set up for equestrian activities with a 65x35 Ebb & Flow arena complete with show jumps and 1km sand and shell riding track.





A striking mix of black corrugate colour steel & lineal cedar cladding on this three bedroom home is a bold addition to the peaceful country landscape it sits within.

Designed with a compact footprint for an efficient use of space the cost effective layout is centred around family living spaces, flowing out onto a north-facing deck that takes in expansive views of the surrounding farm. Stacked sliders in the living area create a seamless flow onto the outdoor living area.

Raked ceilings throughout the main living and kitchen area create spacious proportions and "groove and batten" detailing complements the large feature barn door.

Polished concrete floors add another aesthetic dimension to this modern cottage and will remain comfortable in winter with under floor heating.
